- A motion was made by J. Sweet, seconded by McLallen to approve the sale of the 2009 police cruiser for \$5100.00 to South Pymatuming Township with South Pymatuming Township paying for any and all transfer fees. Motion carried unanimously.
- ➤ A motion was made by McLallen, seconded by Ewing to pay invoices 15-13-1, 15-13-2, & 15-13-3 to Al Wodzianski for work he performed for the borough. Deferring payment of invoice 14-03-1 until Al Wodzianski provides more detailed description of work done.

- ➤ A motion was made by Ewing, seconded by J. Sweet to use a maximum of \$3500.00 out of the Fred Hauser Fund toward the building of the pavilion in the park. Funds from the Jason Powell Foundation will also be used in the building of the pavilion. Motion carried unanimously.
- ➤ A motion was made by Ewing, seconded by McLallen to build a pavilion 16 x 24 in the park. McLallen resended her second motion on the 16 x 24 pavilion. Motion did not carry.
- A motion was made by McLallen, seconded by Ewing for a 24 x 28 pavilion in the park. With the 24 x 28 pavilion being the last structure to be built on the southwest side of the park. Future construction is to be done across the road in the park. Unless the building is a replacement to an existing structure. Motion carried. J. Sweet opposed.
- > A motion was made by Moeller, seconded by McLallen to build the pavilion parallel to the sidewalk. Motion carried. J. Sweet opposed.
