

**REGULAR SESSION MEETING JUNE 1, 2010**

Council met in regular session on Tuesday, June 1, 2010 at 7:06 pm in the Council Chambers.

**PRESENT** were President Sweet, who presided, Ewing, Smeltz and McLallen. Mayor Ehrman, Chief DiMaria and Maintenance Supervisor Moeller were also present. Phil Rau of the Record Argus represented the press.

**OPENING:** President Sweet opened the meeting with a salute to the flag and welcomed all in attendance. President Sweet reviewed the announcements, correspondence and presented the monthly reports to the members of Council.

**MINUTES:** Motion by McLallen, seconded by Ewing to approve the minutes from the May 4<sup>th</sup> regular session. The motion was carried unanimously.

**VISITORS**

The visitors in attendance were: Thomas Mills, Richard Foust, Robert Foust, Rina Hart, Michael Heckman and Victor Staples.

Mr. Richard Foust and Mr. Robert Foust discussed the status of the property maintenance issues of 22 Oak Street with Council. They provided Council with a list of dates of previous discussions along with the status reports that they had been given and questioned what the true status of the complaint is. Council will contact Solicitor and provide them with a response.

Mr. Victor Staples asked Council to consider putting all or a portion of the Borough owned 27 acres along Fairground Road out for bid.

Mr. Michael Heckman discussed with Council the status of the property maintenance issues of 75 Lake Street. Council will contact Mr. Jeff Richardson and provide him with a response. Mr. Heckman also informed Council that the storm drain located by Dr. Morelli's office is full and needs cleaned. Maintenance Supervisor Moeller informed all that the storm drain in question is non-functioning due to the fact that a water line runs directly through that drain.

**MAYOR'S REPORT**

Mayor Ehrman discussed with Council that Chief DiMaria had completed his traffic study along Franklin Street and he could not see where there was any real issue with the current situation. Mayor Ehrman also reported to Council that all of Chief DiMaria's reports were in order and that the surveillance project should be finalizing in the next week.

**COMMITTEE REPORTS****WATER & SEWER**

- ⇒ Council reviewed the letter regarding the sewer system at 55 Elm Street Extension. This was to be referred to Attorney Chad Michaelson to be resolved.
- ⇒ The Water Distribution System Improvements Project should be ready to start searching for financing by the end of July 2010.

FACILITIES, GROUNDS & SAFETY

- ⇒ Motion by Ewing, seconded by McLallen to approve the Park reservation on Friday, July 30<sup>th</sup> from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM. The motion was carried unanimously.

FINANCE & PROPERTY

- ⇒ Council reviewed the Treasurer's Report.
- ⇒ Motion by McLallen, seconded by Ewing to approve the payment of bills dated 5/6/10, 5/21/10 and 6/2/10. The motion was carried unanimously.
- ⇒ Motion by Sweet, seconded by Smeltz to approve the rental of the Crack Sealing Machine for one week in September. Motion was carried unanimously.
- ⇒ Council discussed possibly purchasing a new backhoe. Price sheets were handed out and it will be discussed in more detail next month.
- ⇒ Council discussed that the bids for the roof repair were not ready for this month.

BUDGET

- ⇒ Motion by McLallen, seconded by Sweet to approve the 2009 Audit as presented and discussed last month. The motion was carried unanimously.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

President Sweet announced that he had discussed House Bill 2431 (Regular Session 2009-2010) with Representative Brooks. She will vote against this bill if it ever comes out of Committee for a vote.

**NEW BUSINESS**

Maintenance Supervisor Moeller presented to Council that he heard PennDOT has moved up the SR62 Bridge Replacement Project date from sometime in 2011 to September 2010.

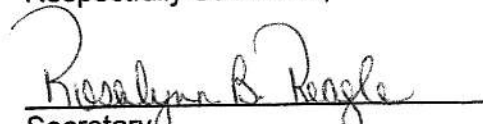
**QUESTIONS FROM THE MEDIA**
