He discussed and provided Council with information on the Revival process and had stated that the members of the Authority had discussed this issue with Attorney Roger Shaffer. There is a time frame of five years to have the Authority revived and it will need to be done with both Stoneboro's and Sandy Lake's Councils. Attorney Douglas stated that he would get in contact with Attorney Shaffer.

Ms. Colleen Pokorny discussed with Council wanting the cement stairway along Walnut Street designated no parking. Council, Attorney Douglas and Ms. Pokorny held discussions and Attorney Douglas stated he would advise Council of his opinion by next month's session.

### WATER & SEWER

- The reservoir cover repairs were kind of a success. We repaired about 80% of the issues
- > The repairs to be done at the bottom of Lake Street should be completed in the next week or two. Will most likely be a day and a half to a two day job and will most likely be putting about 94 connections out of water service during that repair.
- > The Oak Street repairs are completed.

### FINANCE

- Council reviewed the Treasurer's Report.
- ➤ Motion by McLallen, seconded by Patterson to approve the payment of bills dated 10/23/14 and 11/5/14 as amended. The motion was carried unanimously.
- Motion by McLallen, seconded by J. Sweet to advertise the proposed 2015 budget and Ordinance No. 503, setting the tax rate for 2015. The motion was carried unanimously.

## PLANNING COMMISSION

J. Sweet informed Council that there will be a Zoning Hearing Board meeting in the Council Chambers on November 13<sup>th</sup> at 7pm for a variance request on Branch Street.

# SPECIAL EXPLORATION COMMITTEE

McLallen stated that she will be bringing a crane down to the building to take a look at the roof to come up with more economical ideas as to its repair/replacement.

### **UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

Council discussed the Sluice Pipe draft Ordinance. Motion by Moeller, seconded by J. Sweet to advertise the Ordinance. Council held more discussions. The motion was carried unanimously.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

Motion By J. Sweet, seconded by McLallen to give each of the employees a \$50 gift certificate to McKean's Surfine for Thanksgiving. The motion was carried by a majority 6 -1 (Glenn abstained with the reason....he is an employee)
