The motion carried unanimously.
- A motion was made by Moeller, seconded by J. Sweet to advertise the new Water Ordinance. The motion carried unanimously.

FACILITIES, GROUNDS & SAFETY

- A motion was made by Ewing, seconded by Patterson to appoint Laurie McLallen to be the point of contact for the Hazard Mitigation Plan, with the Mercer County Dept. of Safety. The motion carried unanimously.


